



Transportation

Transportation of students to and from Mount Carmel is achieved in a variety of ways:

- 1. MOUNT CARMEL'S PRIVATE BUS SYSTEM** operates solely for its students, using professional, insured drivers. The buses are routed through areas of the city and suburbs. Reasonable fares and convenient routes make this a secure mode of transportation for hundreds of Mount Carmel students. Any students participating in athletics and extracurricular activities may use the activity buses. These buses leave the school campus at 6 p.m. on regular school days, and 3 p.m. on half-day schedules.
- 2. THE METRA RAILROAD** is used by numerous students. The entrance to the 63rd Street Station is directly across the street from the Mount Carmel Student Center on 64th Street. Discount student train tickets are sold in the Main Office.
- 3. THE SOUTH SHORE RAILROAD** shares the same access as the Metra, and serves students from Northwest Indiana. Student discount tickets are available in the Main Office, but all tickets must be ordered in advance.
- 4. CTA** buses also transport students to Mount Carmel, with stops on 63rd Street and Stony Island Avenue. CTA Magnetic Student Riding Permits are sold in the Main Office.
- 5. AMPLE PARKING** exists for those who choose to drive to school.
